
## Advocate

Morelock Services is addressing alley clean-up/illegal dumping with grant support from the City of Columbus, while the SID Cleaning Ambassadors address the boundaries of the SID territory. We attack the problems that are obvious, but we are always interested in feedback from the community to identify problem spots to address.




